Using that Username and Password, please go to the website: www.edithsteincircle.com and on the left hand corner at the bottom you will see the section: Member Login. Type in your email address as your Username, and then using that Password you received in that October email, copy and paste it into the Password slot. Then click Log in and follow the instructions that will appear on screen. It is a very user-friendly system. One member said it works like a "charm".
